We have had yet another month of turmoil in our personal lives with me having to have two stents placed in my heart arteries. All seems to be well and we are physically ready to go. The storms of life are a lot easier to handle when your house is built on the Rock. We sure have had a lot of storms lately. But God is always good to those that love Him and called according to His purpose.

All of our churches are still closed due to the virus, but all of our pastors are preaching each week over the internet and having a lot of people tuning in. We also are continuing our TV broadcast on Mongolian National Television with the airing of the 180 movie. We are showing that twice a week. The gospel will not be hindered.

One of our young church leaders lived most of his life in the Government orphanage in UlaanBaatar. God has given him a heart to reach the orphans that live in the same place he grew up. Even with the strict lock down of all public meetings, God made a way for us to rent buses and take all the older orphans to participate in an indoor basketball tournament with our church youth. So we rented a local gym played some basketball and then preached the gospel to the group. Most of the orphans had never heard, but many prayed to receive. We thank the Lord for allowing us to be able to do this. Mongolia has very strict lock down policies but God and His gospel will continue.

Last week in Thailand we held our monthly hospital visitation gospel outreach program. All of our leper home workers and church workers go and blanket the local hospital with gifts of food baskets and salvation tracts and literature. We also personally witness when we are allowed. Our co workers visit the patients, hospital workers and visitors in the waiting rooms. We had a good response to the gospel with reports of many praying to receive Christ. Your prayer and support funds this outreach. Thank you.

Please pray for the borders to open so we can get back home to Mongolia. We are wanting to continue our new church plant when the quarantine is lifted. We thank you for your support of this work and for your help for my Mom, Joann Tillman. Your love and care for her has been wonderful. We can't do it without your prayer and support. May God continue to bless you in Christ.
