Dear Friends in Christ,

Hello to all in the name of Jesus. We want to thank you for your prayer and support. Baljmaa's Mom, Oyumaa, is still doing the same and stable due to your prayers. We thank you. Baljmaa is still in Mongolia and out of quarantine and working in our pro-life centers and orphanage. The country of Mongolia has instituted a very harsh and strict lockdown due to the never ending covid virus. Baljmaa can travel freely because of our Gobi hospital. She has a medical permit and is a Mongolian nurse and able to move around the city by bus. Other than a few people out and about, the city is barren, and no one can go in or out of what ever city or village they are in. It is difficult and is scheduled to end May the 11<sup>th</sup>.

My children and I continue to visit churches and update the ministry while we are still stateside. We are staying busy and look forward to when we can be back together in Mongolia and Thailand.

Ministry Update: Even with the lockdown, women are still filing into our prolife centers. They come on foot and not cars that are being monitored with roadblocks. All our centers are open and fully operational. Because of your prayer, God gave us the medical permit and can remain open as a necessary business. We are seeing ladies being saved during this difficult time for the Mongolian people. Even though we are hindered sometimes, God is working and never sleeps. Psalms 121:4.

Children are coming and slipping into our Hope Center to eat and hold Bible study. The way they are undetected by the virus guards, is to come two by two and meet up at the center. When they all get together, we have Bible and feed them. They tell Baljmaa that they do not like being away from their church family at the Hope Center and will do what ever it takes to come and meet.

Mongolia is now the epicenter of the virus in Asia with more cases per capita than any other country. The Gobi Desert central government ask if they could use our hospital to house and treat Covid patients due to the government facilities being full. After giving permission we shortly filled up with people from all over the Gobi. All our workers are wearing hazmat suits and sharing the Gospel with all the new unbelievers that fill our beds. The more difficult the time in peoples lives, the more they turn to God. God has used this virus to allow us to see many turn to Him.

In Thailand we had one of our lepers die this past week and we were able to bury him. We held a Christian funeral and many lost family members heard the Gospel. We are always thankful for the opportunity to preach the Gospel.

Please continue to pray for the opening of the borders and for my mother-in-law Oyumaa. We are grateful for your prayer and support.
