SUMMER CAMP ULAANBAATAR MONGOLIA 2022

Dear Friends In Christ,

August 2022

It has finally happened after a couple of years of Covid lockdowns and restrictions. We were able to hold our yearly summer camp. We believe it turned out to be a great event with many people in attendance. With all Covid rules lifted, we were allowed to have as many campers as we were able to handle and 262 showed up. This is our yearly big event, and we praise God for allowing us to continue our work at hand. The Gospel.

Once a year we rent a camping area that is owned by a Christian missionary organization out of Seoul Korea. They rent it to different church groups to have meetings each year usually during the summer months. It is situated about 1hr. outside the capital city on the banks of the Tuul river. It accommodates around 500 people with an enclosed eating hall and covered sleeping areas. All the campers must bring their own bedding and toiletries. We furnish the food and pay for the camp site rental. We also furnish transportation for groups that are attending camp from our Gobi and city ministries. We also encourage everyone to bring lost friends and family members so they too can hear the gospel. During the day, like church camps in the U.S., we have fun and games, and in the early evening we have gospel meetings, and all in attendance must come to the evening service. On Saturday afternoon we baptize and then we close the camp with Sunday morning church service.

This year we had 27 professions of faith and the same were baptized. We praise the Lord for the 27 decisions to put their faith and hope in Christ and follow Him in baptism.

In the coming months we will hold discipleship classes with Tengis teaching the class. Please pray for the new Christians as they attend and that they will grow in Christ.

Our camp each year requires a lot of work (organizing, cooking, overseeing) and additional funds over our regular support. We want to thank you for your sacrificial giving to make this possible each year. We are grateful to our Mongolian coworkers who did the hard work to put all of this together. Everyone did a fantastic job. We thank our Lord for speaking to the hearts of the lost souls who decided to receive Christ. We are truly grateful.

Our desire is for everyone in Mongolia to hear the gospel and to know Christ. Thank you for partnering with us to help us fulfill not only our desire but the Lords too.
