Because of your prayers, we will hold off scheduling surgery until we have more downtime to be in rehab. If the pain returns, we will take care of it but as of right now the Lord has answered your prayers yet again and I am pain free and able to continue the Lord's work.

We have been Stateside visiting some of our Church partners. God has blessed us with a full calendar, plus we have had a great time seeing friends and updating the ministry. Every Sunday is filled until our return to Mongolia in June. We are planning on having many guests visit this summer and must get back and help organize summer camp that begins in late June.

We receive monthly reports from our Pastors and ministry leaders and will share a couple of them with you from February.

Our pro-life centers have become quite busy in the last few months to the point that we were forced into scheduling appointments for our patients. We keep records in Mongolia of the activities at all the centers and would like to share last months with you.



Rocky Face Baptist Church in Canton NC keeps us supplied with beanie babies which can be used as a powerful tool when given to young ladies contemplating aborting their baby. Pictured at left is one of the 137 young women that visited one of the centers in February with ending the life of her unborn child on her mind. She is pictured standing with our ultrasound operator. She is one of the 71 that decided not to have an abortion and keep her child. The good news is that after seeing a photo of her child and hearing the gospel she also prayed and made a profession of faith and hopefully will be at summer camp in June to be baptized. This past month we had 35 young ladies make professions of faith. We praise the Lord for that, and we thank God for your help in reaching them with the Gospel. All our clients receive full Bibles or New Testament upon visiting our centers. We are always in need for Bibles. If the centers are working, we are passing out Bibles. If God leads you to help in purchasing Bibles, we would appreciate it.

Our Churches are doing well, especially our new plant located at the English School in downtown Ulaanbaatar. We are continuing to pray for a Pastor. We ask that you continue to pray with us for this need. We have many who are attending discipleship class. Pictured at right are 4 young men that have recently been saved. They attend our English class and Church. Please pray for them as they are disciplined and grow in Christ.

We also have reports from Gobi Pastor Gan-ulzii that the Church in Erdenedalai has experienced some new growth. He said that they have been close to full over the past few Sundays.



This picture at left was emailed to us from the month of February this year. This looks like a pretty good size group considering that the average daytime temperature this month is -15 in Mongolia. We praise the Lord.



In February we had four new babies, all infants under 3 months old placed in our orphanage. All were abandoned by the parents and were delivered to us by the local police. The girl pictured at left is in poor condition due to malnutrition. We have not given her a name, but God knows her, and we ask that you pray for her health. We have a good medical team at the orphanage but medical care in Mongolia is average at best and she needs God's help and prayer. Thank you and we will let you know next month how she is doing.
