Dear Friends in Christ,

September 2023

Hello to all in the name of Jesus. This has been a very busy month for us in Mongolia and Thailand. In Mongolia we have had very heavy rains and floods that has greatly hindered our travel around the city. We thank the Lord for the needed rain but praise Him that it's finally over. We have had a lot of guests this summer and it's difficult to get around in a bus with all the water. But everything is back to normal at the time of this writing.

We have a couple of Baptist Pastor friends in Mississippi and Tennessee who have a church planting ministry with several Russian pastors. They meet a couple of times a year with them in Russia but have been unable to meet and get their financial support transferred to a Russian bank due to the war with Ukraine. They reached out to us to see if we could help bring them together in Mongolia. We were able to accommodate them all by supplying transportation, helping them find an apartment large enough for them to stay and supplying them with a translator that speaks English and Russian. Baljmaa helped and our son Ganna had a friend that also helped translate the meetings. Even though they are not partners with our ministry it was a blessing to be able to help others do the Lord's work.

We were honored this month to have Dr Adam Sloan from Beacon of Hope Ministries visit our hospital in the Gobi to hold a two-day medical mission for the people of the Gobi Desert. They gave free care and treated over 300 patients. They made a big impact on the Gobi nomads and the gospel. Every patient was witnessed to and given gospel literature to complete their visit. We are thankful for Dr. Sloan, his family and whole medical team who took their time and used their finances to help be a light and share the gospel with the people of the Gobi Desert. They are a blessing.

When our orphans in Mongolia reach 6 or 7 years of age, we must move them to the government orphanage due to the expense and our limited room. We are set up to only care for small children. This year the government informed us that they did not have the funds to take our older children and care for them. But because of your prayer and support, we will continue to care for them. We have about 5 children that are staying with us and we have enrolled them in public school. We are still having Christian kindergarten for the children in our orphanage but not first grade and up. We praise the Lord for your prayers and support that allows us to continue taking care of the orphans. Governments may let us down, but God never fails.

Prayer Request: The director of our Leper Home in Thailand fell and suffered some minor brain damage, in his own words, that required surgery. He is recovering and back at work after two weeks in the hospital. His nick name is A. We ask if you will pray for his full recovery. We sure do need him.

My mother Joann is doing well, and we appreciate all you do for her. She asks me to tell you all that she loves you and thanks you for taking care of her with your continued support and prayers.

We are very close to having our Mongolian web page ready to advertise on TV and radio. Please keep heaven.mn in prayer as God will use it to reach many with the gospel.

We all at Harbor Evangelism want to thank you for your financial help and your prayers for us and God's work. You are a big part of our labor to reach the people of Thailand and Mongolia with the gospel of God. We thank you
