Because of your prayer and support we were able to open a new feeding center where we are feeding 30 children each and having daily Bible study with them. This is the ministry that Tengis and a few of the youth in our home church started and are there serving daily. These centers are a tremendous way of reaching children and their families with the gospel. This will be our 4th children's feeding station and gospel center. Please pray that the Lord will bless Tengis and the center, and many will be saved.

Due to the harsh climate of Mongolia we quite often are forced into remodeling our facilities where our feeding centers, orphanages, and other places that house our outreach works. This past month our son Ganaa has been busy redoing our first prolife center. It was in bad need of repair and one of our partners in Decatur, Alabama donated the needed funds to do the job. We are grateful for all the help our partners in the States have given us.

We had two of our long time Pastors resign a couple of months ago to go in different directions in service to the Lord. They left on good terms and are seeking Gods will in their lives. Please pray for them and us as we look to find men to fill their spots. We ask that you pray for God to send the labors.

Several months ago, we asked for prayer for one of our long-time children's teachers and friend Ganbat. She had cancer that went into remission after much prayer and chemo. The cancer has returned and has spread. We ask again that you pray for her and her family for God to heal her and give them peace in this situation.

All is going well in the daily operations concerning our ministries. The gospel is being preached. Poor children are being fed. Babies and mothers are being saved in the prolife centers. We owe it all to God and you. Your partnership is the key to our success. We are eternally grateful for your help. This summer we have many people scheduled to visit us in Mongolia and serve with us as we all reach the lost with the gospel. But we always have room for one more. Pray concerning coming to visit and serve with us. We would be blessed. Please remember to pray for us.

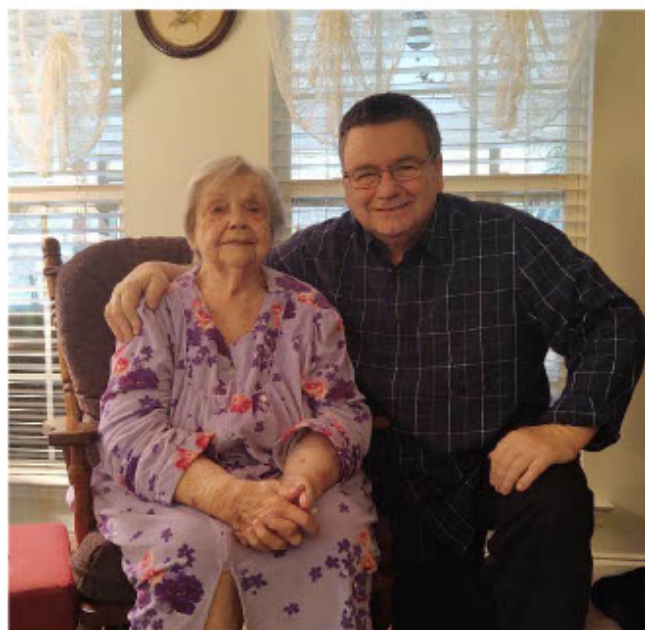

Mom will be 90 years of age April 10th, 2024. She recently lost her sister who was 93 years old. My mom's family has good genes. She has had several close family members that have passed in the last

few years, but God still is able to keep her in good spirits. My mother is one of the best Christians I have ever known, and her joy is an inspiration to our whole family.



She is now an official shut in and only goes out to make the occasional trip to the grocery store with her granddaughter Sarah who lives with her full-time. Sarah is a blessing to us all and especially my mother. Sarah takes total care of mom which allows us to continue the work of the Lord. Sarah is also the office manager of Harbor Evangelism. Please keep her in prayer, she has her hands full.

Mom is almost completely blind and deaf and walks with a walker when she goes from room to room. But she still has 100% of her mental faculties and is sharp as a tack. Mom also has heart problems with A-fib and makes regular trips to the doctor to keep her meds

updated. Everything else is well with her except the occasional fall but God has kept her falls on a rug or carpet. All in all, mom is doing well for her age.
