Hello from everyone at Harbor Evangelism. One of the greatest blessings that we can receive is to see our fruit bearing their own fruit. This is the very thing that is occurring in our ministry in Mongolia. Our work in Mongolia was built and is still being built on Discipleship. The people that we have led to the Lord and discipled are doing the same thing that God allowed us to teach them. We teach them to make disciples too. Last week Tengis took 15 new believers that are in his class and traveled to the Gobi once again to spread the Gospel. They traveled to many villages passing out tracts, the printed book of Mark, and New Testaments. They witnessed to all who would listen and invited them to Church. Tengis reported that the group was able to share the Gospel, one on one, with over 100 people. The team also gave out our last box of New Testaments. We will be headed back to Mongolia in 10 days of this writing. We will order and purchase more New Testaments upon our arrival. In our last prayer letter, we expressed a need for funds to purchase Bibles and a vehicle for our ministry in Mongolia. We are blessed to have such great partners because you answered our request. We were able to purchase the SUV for the Gobi Desert travels and purchase many Bibles. We will report with photos next month on these essential needs that God led you to supply. We are grateful to you and our Lord.

**Prayer Request:** This June the 21<sup>st</sup> through the 23<sup>rd</sup> will be our annual Summer Camp. We are expecting a good crowd, and we ask that you pray for souls to be saved. Over the 20 years or more that we have had Summer Camp, we have been able to Baptize around 2500 people. God has blessed us in seeing many turn to Christ through your prayer and His desire to see people repent. Please pray for this year's camp that many will be saved.

One of our long time Church Ladies from Ulaanbaatar returned to her village in the Gobi and asked us if we could help her start a children's church after she moved back home. God supplied us with the funds to purchase the small building in her village. After Summer Camp we will help her start up the church with tables and chairs and children's Bibles. We also ask you to pray that God will use this new Children Church to lead many Children and adults to Christ through the teaching of His Word. This will be the only Gospel light in this village of about 2000 souls.

We are sad to report that another one of our lepers passed away last month in Thailand. He prayed to be saved and repented about 2 months ago. We are so happy that he will spend eternity in Heaven with Jesus if he was sincere in his prayer. Your partnership with us allows these forgotten people to be reached with the love of Christ. Thank you.

We love you in Christ and are so grateful to you for making it possible for us to serve in Mongolia and Thailand. Because of your prayer and financial support people can hear the gospel and are being saved. **Prayer Works.**
